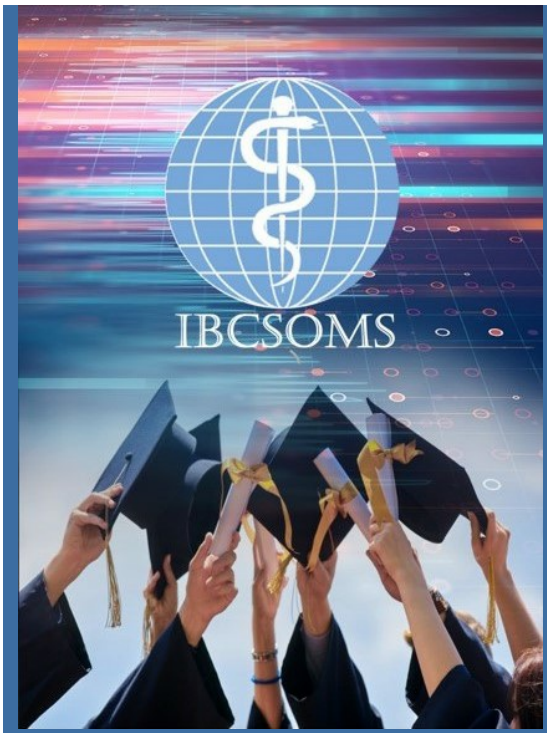

Featuring our Fellows

In our second issue of the Fellows Spotlight, we continue to showcase the

remarkable work being done by our Fellows around the world. This month, we are pleased to feature **Dr. Masako Fujioka-Kobayashi** and **Dr. Pramod Subash**, BDS, MDS, DNB, MNAMS, FIBCSOMS.



Dr. Masako Fujioka-Kobayashi graduated from Tokushima University, Japan, earning her DDS in 2008 and completing her PhD in 2013. From 2015 to 2020, she trained as a Scientific Associate at the University of Bern, Switzerland, where she gained extensive experience in translational and clinical research. She subsequently joined Nippon Dental University, Tokyo, as Associate Professor in the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. Since April 2024, she has served as **Associate Professor at Shimane University Faculty of Medicine.**

Her clinical and academic interests span the full spectrum of oral and maxillofacial surgery, including the management of maxillofacial trauma, dentofacial deformities, and oral and head-and-neck cancers. She integrates clinical expertise with research, contributing to evidence-based approaches and advancing knowledge through both clinical and basic science investigations. She has authored approximately 100 peer-reviewed international publications and has actively participated in national and international educational workshops and collaborative research projects.

Certified as an IBCSOMS Fellow in 2024, Dr. Fujioka-Kobayashi is dedicated to promoting global excellence in oral and maxillofacial surgery. She is committed to mentoring the next generation of clinicians,



Dr. Pramod Subash is an American Board-certified oral and maxillofacial surgeon with extensive international training and academic leadership in craniomaxillofacial surgery. He earned his BDS (1997) and MDS (2001) from the A.B. Shetty Institute, completed a residency at the University of Maryland Medical Center in 2008, and is a Diplomate of the National Board of Examinations, India. Since 2013, he has served as **Professor and Chief of Cranio-Maxillofacial Surgery at the Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences in Kochi, Kerala, India.**

His clinical and academic interests include cleft and craniofacial surgery, congenital and acquired facial deformities, TMJ surgery including arthroscopy and total joint replacement, and complex craniofacial reconstruction using virtual surgical planning, 3D printing, and minimally invasive techniques. A passionate educator and PhD mentor at Amrita Vishwa Vidyapeetham, he has authored numerous publications and led national and international workshops in orthognathic and craniofacial surgery.

Certified as an IBCSOMS Fellow in 2024, Dr. Subash is dedicated to advancing global oral and maxillofacial surgery through innovation, education, and mentorship.
